**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** This three-day training will provide basic information on the PA model for the Student Assistance Program (SAP). Instruction and discussion will include the history and philosophy of the PA model, SAP team roles, the SAP Core Team process, methods for effective student and parent engagement, resilience-building strategies, current ATOD concerns and appropriate interventions, identification of students' observable behaviors that may be signs of behavioral health concerns, and review of available community resources. Participants will be prepared to sit on SAP teams or serve as support personnel for SAP programs in schools and/or behavioral health agencies.
